The High – Level Taskforce on COVID – 19 Pandemic

The High-Level Taskforce on COVID-19 Pandemic held its 46th Meeting on Thursday 7th 2020 under the Chairmanship of **H.E. Dr. Riek Machar Teny-Dhurgon**, the First Vice President and Deputy Chairman of the **High-Level Taskforce on COVID-19 Pandemic**.

The High-Level Taskforce noted the briefing by H.E. First Vice President on the decisions taken by the Presidency in its meeting on COVID-19 on Thursday 7th May 2020, under the chairmanship of President Salva Kiir Mayardit. In the light of this meeting, the Presidency took the following measures and will be effective in 72 hours:

Checking inn; (must strongly observe)

1. Social distancing
2. Wearing of Face Mask all the time while in the Airport
3. Wearing of Hand Globes should be observed maintain by the passengers during checking inn and
4. While in the air social distancing should be observed while taking their seats in the aircraft

During Flight

1. Wear Face masks, hands gloves; before, during, after flights at all time
2. Maintain social distancing inside the aircraft

On arrival;

1. Produce COVID 19 Free Status Certificate or authenticated Certificate upon arrival and
2. Do screening upon arrival and maintain social distancing in the process of screening
3. Wear masks, hands gloves which should be provided the operators
4. On arrival go for 14 days self quarantine on your own expense.
5. The aircraft should be sprayed immediately when the aircraft has come into a full stop
6. The cost of spraying should be taken care of by the Air operators Company)

These measure/guide lines shall apply to all airlines during the COVID-19 Pandemic operations
