Update on COVID-19 response

Date: 3rd July, 2020

In the last 24 hours, 56 samples were tested and results released. Of these, twenty two (22) tested positive for COVID19. Out of the new cases identified, 17 are male adults and 5 are female adults.

Continue to observe the instructions of Health Authorities particularly washing hands regularly with water and soap; maintaining physical distance from other people (at least keep 2 meters (6 feet) distance between two individuals) and mandatory facemask or cloth face coverings in public.
