Update on COVID-19 response

In the last 24 hours, 87 samples were tested and results released. Of these, seven (7) tested positive for COVID19. Out of the new cases identified, 6 are male adults and 1 is female adult.

Continue to observe the instructions of Health Authorities particularly washing hands regularly with water and soap; maintaining physical distance from other people (at least keep 2 meters (6 feet) distance between two individuals) and mandatory facemask or cloth face coverings in public.
